Thank you for your enquiry concerning the temporary post of English teacher at St Richard's Catholic College. The position has arisen due to a member of the Department requiring surgery and post-operation recovery time. You will need to be a well-qualified, inspirational and outstanding teacher ready to take on the responsibility of maximising the potential of pupils of all abilities. You will be a good to outstanding classroom practitioner with high expectations for all.

The English department is an aspirational and forward-thinking one, with a team of talented and enthusiastic professionals. It is looking for someone who will maintain its high standards (82% A*-C in 2016) and extend pupils' talents beyond the curriculum.
