At St Richard's Catholic College, we will therefore endeavour to:

1. Work towards including Fairtrade in our College Improvement Plan and to promote Fairtrade throughout the curriculum and as a cross-curriculum activity (projects, block day).
2. Support and expand the work of the Fairtrade Steering Group represented by a number of staff and pupils.
3. Continue to use Fairtrade products wherever possible (Reception, Staff, PTFA) and encourage the use of Fairtrade products throughout the college as much as possible (staff, canteen suppliers, individual department).
4. Provide the opportunity for the school community to buy some Fairtrade products during school events such as, PTFA events (quizzes, summer fayre).
5. Raise pupils and public awareness of the need for Fairtrade and the importance of the Fairtrade mark in accordance with the Fairtrade vision.
6. Support Fairtrade Fortnight, extending our support to our local towns (Bexhill, Hastings and Eastbourne) during some of their Fairtrade events during the year.
7. Update our Fairtrade displays and advertise our Fairtrade activities.
8. Remember the people working towards a fairer world in our prayers.
