

## **School Improvement Support Offer 2018-2019**

The Department for Education have simplified the School Improvement Offer for 2018-19 by moving away from large regional bids to focus more specifically on those schools who need additional help and support. The DfE will contact local authorities, dioceses and academy trusts. The Teaching School Council will match National Leaders of Education (NLEs) to eligible schools and the NLEs will undertake action planning visits to those schools who request support.

### **The voluntary offer will include;**

Tier 1. 3 days of NLE support for all eligible schools

Tier 2. Up to £16,000 for schools identified.

### **To be eligible for support**

Tier 1. Schools who are below floor targets and or received an Ofsted grading of RI

Tier 2. Schools who have received an Ofsted grading of RI twice.

### **How the offer will work.**

From Spring 2019 the identified schools will be contacted and offered the support available. If schools choose to take advantage of the offer their chosen NLE will lead the process and work with the school to support the leadership team and identify the specific support required.
