Dear Applicant

Thank you for your enquiry concerning the temporary part-time post of RE teacher (part-time) at St Richard's Catholic College. I hope you will find the enclosed information informative and that you will decide to apply for the post which is from 20th April until the end of the summer term.

The college roll is at present 1032. The college enjoys an excellent reputation in the community and our numbers for admissions are over-subscribed each year. The examination results (2018-19) were 78% 4-9 grades in English and Maths and 59% 5-9 grades including Maths and English (BASICS measure).

Our last OFSTED inspection (2006) rated the school as outstanding as did our most recent Diocesan Inspection (November 2018). Visitors to the college often comment on our 'strong' family atmosphere, supportive ethos and Christ-centred caring environment. Pupils are positive, respectful and fully engaged in their learning. They enjoy coming to school and each is encouraged to develop to the full. Ours is a 'can do' culture with the belief that everyone can achieve. We are a National Teaching School and a Specialist Science College with High Performing Specialist School status and we have Leading Edge status, International School status, Prince's Teaching Institute 2018 Mark, Fairtrade Fair Achiever Award status, Artsmark Gold Award, Space Education Quality Mark as well as Gifted and Talented Lead School status. During 2018-19, the school was awarded three Exceptional Education Awards at Transforming level in 'Climate for Learning', 'Leadership with Moral Purpose' and 'Engagement with Stakeholders'. Our Diocesan Inspection of November 2018 rated the school 'outstanding' in every aspect. We are ambitious to become one of the best schools in England.

The RE department is an outstanding department and we would expect the successful candidate to contribute to its continuing success as the most successful department in the school. Academically, the pupils achieve exceptionally well with 88% of pupils achieving 9-4 grades and 74% achieving 9-5 grades and nearly 40% achieving 9-7 in GCSE in 2019. Additionally, the RE department has a crucial role to play in maintaining the Catholic ethos of the college. The department works closely with the Lay Chaplain and opportunities are made during RE lessons to promote the spirituality of the pupils.

The RE department is an aspirational one, with a team of talented, hard-working and enthusiastic staff. It is looking for someone with drive, enthusiasm and a passion for all aspects of RE. He/she must be creative in all aspects of his/her work to enthuse and motivate pupils so that they gain hands-on experience, opportunities beyond the classroom as well as innovative teaching practice. We are committed to providing enrichment opportunities for our pupils so applicants must be willing to support trips and clubs as well as lead future enrichment events. This is a great opportunity for someone looking to further enhance their career in a supportive, forward-thinking school or for an NQT beginning their teaching career.
