

## 2022 GCSE RESULTS

- 86% of pupils achieved English and maths at grade 4 or above. This is well above the National and the County averages
- 74% of pupils achieved English and maths at grade 5. This is well above the National and the County averages. It is also 1% higher than last year's TAGs
- 60% achieved the baccalaureate (% grade 4 Inc. English, Maths, Science, MFL and History/Geography)
- 53% achieved the baccalaureate (% grade 5 Inc. English, Maths, Science, MFL and History/Geography)
- EBACC score was 5.7 based on a 63% full entry. Overall attainment 8 is 60.6 which is above the College target of 60.

Grade 7 and above across all subjects was 37% (also higher than last year's TAGs).

We had 69 pupils achieving at least 1 grade 9; 6 pupils achieved at least 7 grade 9s; 2 pupils achieved 10 grade 9s.

## 2021 GCSE RESULTS

- 92% of pupils achieved English and Maths at grade 4 or above. This is well above the National and County averages.
- 73% of pupils achieved English and Maths at grade 5. This is well above the National and the County averages.
- 62% achieved the baccalaureate at grade 4 and above (English, Maths, Science, MFL and Humanities).
- 50% achieved the baccalaureate at grade 5 and above (English, Maths, Science, MFL and Humanities).
- The EBACC score was 5.7 based on a 66% full entry.
- Progress 8 score not applicable as these are Centre Assessed Grades.
- Overall Attainment 8 was 61.5.

We had 30 pupils achieving at least one grade 9. Five pupils qualify for straight 9s (at least seven).

Two pupils achieved 10 grade 9s.

## **2020 GCSE RESULTS**

- 89% of pupils achieved English and Maths at grade 4 or above. This is well above the National and the County averages. (National 68% BASICS)
- 66% of pupils achieved English and Maths at grade 5. This is well above the National and the County averages. (National 50% BASICS)
- 57% achieved the baccalaureate (% grade 4 inc. English, Maths, Science, MFL and Humanities)
- 44% achieved the baccalaureate (% grade 5 inc. English, Maths, Science, MFL and Humanities)
- The average EBACC score was 5.4 based on a 61% full entry.
- Progress 8 score not applicable as these are Centre Assessed Grades
- Overall attainment 8 is 58.3
- Grade 7 and above was 41%
- We had 46 pupils achieving at least 1 grade 9. 4 pupils qualify for straight 9s (at least 7). 2 pupils gained 10 grade 9s.

## **2019 GCSE RESULTS**

- 78% of pupils achieved English and Maths at grade 4 or above. This is well above the National and the County averages. (National 68% BASICS)
- 59% of pupils achieved English and Maths at grade 5. This is well above the National and the County averages. (National 50% BASICS)
- 57% achieved the baccalaureate (%C+ and grade 4 inc. English, Maths, Science, MFL and Humanities)
- 40% achieved the baccalaureate (%C+ and grade 5 inc. English, Maths, Science, MFL and Humanities)
- The average EBACC score was 5.1 (just below B) based on a 70% full entry.
- Progress 8 score is 0.57.
- Overall attainment 8 is 53.9 (55.00 would be B grade equivalent)
- Grade 7 and above was 25%
- We had 27 pupils achieving at least 1 grade 9 with 1 pupil gaining Grade 9 or equivalent in all Year 11 exams (only 837 pupils out of over half a million achieved this nationally)  
95% of pupils continue in education or employment. This data, published in October 2019, is for pupils who completed key stage 4 in 2017, which is the most recent data available.
