Skills and Abilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ability to provide classroom cover, within agreed parameters, in the absence of the class teacher. • Ability to consistently and effectively implement agreed behaviour management strategies. • Ability to use language and other communication skills that pupils can understand and relate to. • Ability to establish positive relationships with pupils and empathise with their needs. • Ability to demonstrate active listening skills. • Ability to provide levels of individual attention, reassurance and help with learning tasks as appropriate to pupils' needs, encouraging the pupils to stay on task. • Ability to monitor the pupils' response to the learning activities as agreed with the teacher to achieve the intended learning outcomes. • Ability to carry out and report on systematic observations of pupils' knowledge, understanding and skills. • Ability to assist in the recording of lessons and assessment as required by the teacher. • Ability to offer constructive feedback to pupils to reinforce self-esteem. • Ability to work effectively and supportively as a member of the school team. • Ability to work within and apply all school policies eg. behaviour management, safeguarding and child protection, Health and Safety, Equal Opportunities, etc.
